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## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

Read Hebrews 11:1-4 together, "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. This is what the ancients were commended for. By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible. By faith Abel brought God a better offering than Cain did. By faith he was commended as righteous, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith Abel still speaks, even though he is dead."

- The author of Hebrews describes faith as something we hope for but cannot see. In other words, faith doesn't mean waiting for God to come through before we take a step of faith.
- Do you find it easy to do that? Is there any area of your life you've needed to trust God's goodness even when you couldn't see it?

Read Proverbs 3:9 together, "Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce."

- What does it look like to honor God with what he's given us?
- A temptation for people can be to give up the things they don't want anymore or things they no longer use. But God asks us to give away our best. What would that be for you?
- Spend time praying together, asking God to show each of you what taking a step of faith looks like individually and as a family.
